Each Beginning with the 2023-2024 school 22 year, each school district in this state may offer a shall provide 23 remediation course for high school students who score below a 2.4 nineteen (19) on the benchmarks on subject-area portions of the

- B. Remediation required by subsection A of this section may include but is not limited to:
 - 1. Extended instructional time during the school day;
 - 2. A summer academy;
 - Tutoring;
 - 4. Online coursework;
- 5. Repetition of any course in which the student has

 demonstrated academic deficiency by scoring below the benchmarks in

 subject-area portions of the ACT or below equivalent scores on the

 SAT; or
- 14 6. Any course designed to address areas of deficiency.
 - C. Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed to require that a teacher providing instruction in the remediation course be certified in any subject matter that is tested on the ACT or SAT exam.
 - D. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

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1	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
