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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1370.10 of Title 68, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1370 of Title 68
21	of the Oklahoma Statutes and in accordance with the provisions of
22	this act, any county of this state may levy a sales tax not to
23	exceed one percent (1%) upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts
24	derived from all sales or services in the county upon which a

1 consumer's sales tax is levied by the state, except as provided in 2 paragraph 8 of Section 1357 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, 3 subject to the following conditions:

The proceeds of such sales tax shall be used solely for the
 purpose of funding emergency medical services; and

Before a sales tax may be levied by the county, the
imposition of the tax shall first be approved by sixty percent (60%)
of the registered voters of the county voting thereon at a special
election called by resolution of the board of county commissioners.

10 The board of county commissioners shall create a limited-Β. purpose fund and deposit therein any revenue generated by any sales 11 12 tax levied pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this 13 section. The fund shall be placed in an insured or collateralized 14 interest-bearing account, and the interest which accrues to the fund 15 shall be retained in the fund. Monies in the limited-purpose fund 16 shall be expended only as accumulated and only for the purpose 17 specifically described in paragraph 1 of subsection A of this 18 section.

C. As used in this section, "Emergency Medical Services" means any emergency medical services system which provides for the organization and appropriate designation of personnel, facilities, and equipment for the effective and coordinated delivery of health care services primarily under emergency conditions within the voting county.
