12 An Act relating to agriculture; creating the
13 International Livestock Judging Competition,
14 Shooting, and Precision Sports Grant Act; creating
15 the International Livestock Judging Competition,
16 Shooting, and Precision Sports Revolving Fund;
17 directing the Department of Agriculture, Food, and
18 Forestry to administer the act; directing the State
19 Board of Agriculture to promulgate rules and adopt
20 certain guidelines; providing for grants; identifying
21 eligible grant recipients; providing for grant
22 limitations; providing for codification; and
23 providing an effective date.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-1 of Title 2, unless there is
3 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "International
5 Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting, and Precision Sports Grant
6 Act".

7 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-2 of Title 2, unless there is
9 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
11 fund for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
12 to be designated the "International Livestock Judging Competition,
13 Shooting, and Precision Sports Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
14 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
15 consist of all monies received by the State Board of Agriculture
16 from state-appropriated funds, federal funds, donations, grants, and
17 contributions from any public or private source and designated for
18 the purpose set forth in this section. All monies accruing to the
19 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
20 expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
21 Forestry for the purpose of administering the International
22 Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting, and Precision Sports Grant
23 Act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued
24 by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law

1 with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
2 Services for approval and payment.

3 B. The International Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting,
4 and Precision Sports Revolving Fund shall never exceed Five Hundred
5 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) at any given time.

6 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-3 of Title 2, unless there is
8 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 A. The Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall
10 administer the provisions of the International Livestock Judging
11 Competition, Shooting, and Precision Sports Grant Act.

12 B. The State Board of Agriculture shall promulgate rules and
13 adopt eligibility guidelines necessary to enforce and administer the
14 International Livestock Judging Competition, Shooting, and Precision
15 Sports Grant Act, including an application process for grants.
16 Teams that receive grants must be comprised of Oklahoma students who
17 are members of a National FFA Organization chapter or 4-H team that
18 has won a national competition and is eligible to compete in an
19 international livestock judging competition or members of a shooting
20 and precision sports team that is eligible to compete in a national
21 or international sports competition.

22 C. Grants shall be awarded to match the funds the teams have
23 raised in a one-to-one ratio (1:1), the total amount not to exceed
24

1 the estimated cost of the trip for an international livestock
2 judging competition.

3 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
