11 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
13 General; transferring remaining balances of prior
14 appropriations to certain revolving funds; specifying
15 amounts; identifying sources and destinations of
16 transfers; providing purposes; providing for
17 noncodification; providing an effective date; and
18 declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 TRANSFER: Of the funds originally appropriated to the Office of
22 the Attorney General pursuant to Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill
23 No. 2958 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
24 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall

1 transfer the sum of Four Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
2 (\$4,550,000.00) to the Victims of Human Trafficking and Prevention
3 Revolving Fund created in Section 748.3 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
4 Statutes to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
6 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

7 TRANSFER: Of the funds originally appropriated to the Office of
8 the Attorney General pursuant to Section 124 of Enrolled Senate Bill
9 No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the
10 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
11 transfer the sum of Seven Million Eight Hundred Ninety-six Thousand
12 Five Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$7,896,567.00) to the Federal
13 Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund created by
14 Enrolled House Bill No. 4066 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma
15 Legislature to be budgeted and expended in accordance with law.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

17 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
