7                                   AS INTRODUCED

8                   An Act relating to schools; directing the Oklahoma  
9                   State Department of Education to develop or acquire  
10                  and implement certain threat intervention training  
11                  program; identifying who the program shall be  
12                  designed for; directing that the program use certain  
13                  approach; providing for codification; and providing  
14                  an effective date.

14   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
16           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100.9 of Title 70, unless  
17           there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18           The Oklahoma State Department of Education shall develop or  
19           acquire and implement a training program designed to help school  
20           staff and faculty identify a potential threat and provide an  
21           opportunity to intervene and support a student on a path to violence  
22           at the school. The training program shall be for staff and faculty  
23           at the middle school through high school levels in all Oklahoma  
24           Districts. The training program must include a research-based

1 approach and incorporate predictive analytics to efficiently  
2 identify, analyze, classify, and deescalate threats of targeted  
3 violence to designated school leaders and administrators so that  
4 appropriate interventions can be utilized to prevent violence.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
