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15	WHEREAS, paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A
16	of the Oklahoma Statutes requires the Workers' Compensation
17	Commission to evaluate the Fee Schedule for maximum rates paid for
18	reimbursement to medical providers and adopt updates or adjustments;

20	WHEREAS, paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A
21	of the Oklahoma Statutes also requires the Workers' Compensation
22	Commission to submit the updated and adjusted Fee Schedule to the

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 8 9 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 10 SECTION 1. The proposed Fee Schedule for maximum rates paid for reimbursement to medical providers, as amended and updated pursuant 11 12 to paragraph 14 of subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A of the 13 Oklahoma Statutes, and submitted to the President Pro Tempore of the 14 Senate, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the 15 Governor, is hereby approved as required by paragraph 14 of 16 subsection H of Section 50 of Title 85A of the Oklahoma Statutes. 17 SECTION 2. Copies of this joint resolution shall be dispatched

18 to the members of the Workers' Compensation Commission, the Governor 19 and the Secretary of State.

20 SECTION 3. This joint resolution shall become effective July 1, 21 2024.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
