22	public health emergencies, including the COVID-19 pandemic; and
23	WHEREAS, nurses are known to be patient advocates, acting to

1	WHEREAS, nurses represent the largest single component of the
2	health care profession, with an estimated population of more than
3	4,000,000 registered nurses in the United States; and
4	WHEREAS, when nurse staffing levels increase, the risk of
5	patient complications and lengthy hospital stays decreases,
6	resulting in cost savings; and
7	WHEREAS, nurses are the cornerstone of the public health
8	infrastructure, promoting healthy lifestyles and educating
9	communities on disease prevention and health promotion; and
LO	WHEREAS, nurses touch the lives of the people of the United
L1	States through every stage of life.
