8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Resolution recognizing April as Sexual Assault
10 Awareness Month and April 26, 2023, as Denim Day;
11 supporting Peace Over Violence and the YWCA.

13 WHEREAS, April is nationally recognized as Sexual Assault
14 Awareness Month and the Peace Over Violence organization has
15 declared April 26, 2023, as Denim Day. Both events draw attention
16 to the misconceptions and misinformation about sexual violence,
17 which remains a serious issue in our society; and

18 WHEREAS, sexual harassment is part of a continuum of violence
19 whose damaging effects are felt throughout our culture. Harmful
20 attitudes about all forms of sexual violence allow these issues to
21 persist and allow victims and survivors to be revictimized; and

22 WHEREAS, every 68 seconds an American is sexually assaulted and
23 approximately one in four women is raped during their lifetime; and

1 WHEREAS, in Oklahoma, the rate of rape and attempted rape among
2 females reported to law enforcement has been 35-45% higher than the
3 U.S. rate for the past decade; and

4 WHEREAS, Oklahoma law enforcement reported 2,245 forcible and
5 attempted rapes in 2020 - which represented 12.5% of all violent
6 crimes, and reported rape cases have increased 21% over the past 3
7 years, and 34.2% overall since 2013; and

8 WHEREAS, youth under 18 account for about 44% of all reported
9 sexual assaults, at least 25% of women experience sexual harassment
10 in the workplace and about 75% of sexual harassment victims
11 experience retaliation when they report it; and

12 WHEREAS, sexual violence and its unfair and traumatizing effects
13 are preventable with proper education on the matter and
14 comprehensive prevention projects; and

15 WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
16 strongly support the efforts of Peace Over Violence and the YWCA of
17 Oklahoma City to educate persons in our state about the true impact
18 of sexual harassment, abuse, assault and rape.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
20 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

21 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes the month
22 of April as Sexual Assault Awareness Month.

23 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives designates April 26,
24 2023, as Denim Day and urges everyone to wear jeans on this day to

1 help communicate the message that there is no excuse and there is
2 never an invitation to harass, abuse, assault or rape.
