11 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to higher education; amending 70 O.S.
13 2021, Section 626.6, which relates to the Oklahoma
14 Higher Education Tuition Aid Act; removing certain
15 eligibility provision; limiting eligibility of
16 certain incarcerated individuals; providing an
17 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 626.6, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 626.6 A. No person shall be awarded a state tuition
22 aid grant unless the person:

1 1. Is a resident of ~~the State of Oklahoma~~ this state. Such
2 residency shall meet requirements as set out by the Oklahoma State
3 Regents for Higher Education;

4 2. Has demonstrated financial need for ~~such~~ tuition aid as
5 determined by Sections 626.2 and 626.7 of this title and in
6 accordance with procedures ~~to be~~ established by the Oklahoma State
7 Regents for Higher Education;

8 3. ~~Is not incarcerated in a state, federal or private~~
9 ~~correctional facility;~~

10 4. Has demonstrated high moral character, good citizenship, and
11 dedication to American ideals;

12 5. ~~4.~~ Has applied for state tuition aid and has been determined
13 to be eligible for such tuition aid; and

14 6. ~~5.~~ Has complied with all the rules adopted pursuant to the
15 Oklahoma Higher Education Tuition Aid Act for the award, regulation,
16 and administration of state college tuition aid.

17 B. No person shall be awarded a state tuition aid grant if the
18 person is incarcerated in a state, federal, or private correctional
19 facility and enrolled in a program structured primarily for virtual
20 learning. A state tuition aid grant shall only be awarded to an
21 individual who is incarcerated in a state, federal, or private
22 correctional facility if the individual is within (5) years from
23 being released from incarceration.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
