9           An Act relating to marijuana; allowing  
10           municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties  
11           to enter into certain agreements or memoranda of  
12           understanding; designating reimbursement rate for  
13           certain equipment usage; providing for codification;  
14           and providing an effective date.

15   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
17           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426.2 of Title 63, unless there  
18           is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19           Municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties may enter  
20           into agreements or memoranda of understanding with state agencies  
21           which respond to search and seizure activities of marijuana to  
22           compensate municipalities, political subdivisions, or counties for  
23           the use of county or municipal equipment during search and seizure  
24           events. Agreements or memoranda made pursuant to the provisions of

1 this section shall not be reimbursed at a higher rate than the  
2 federal schedule rate for equipment usage.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
