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9 An act relating to medical marijuana; directing
10 licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed
11 medical marijuana commercial growers to sell certain
12 medical marijuana products in pre-packaged form;
13 providing requirements for packaging; allowing for
14 the display and smelling of marijuana; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 431.1 of Title 63, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Upon the effective date of this act, all medical marijuana
21 flower, trim, shake, kief, medical marijuana product, or other
22 flower-based product not defined as a concentrate, shall be sold by
23 licensed medical marijuana processors and licensed medical marijuana
24 commercial growers to licensed medical marijuana dispensaries only

1 in pre-packaged form in package sizes weighing not less than one-
2 half (1/2) of one (1) gram to not more than three (3) ounces.

3 B. Nonopaque materials may be used when packaging medical
4 marijuana flower provided all other packaging and labeling
5 requirements for medical marijuana products sold in this state are
6 met and it is placed in an opaque container before leaving a
7 licensed medical marijuana dispensary.

8 C. The display and smelling of medical marijuana shall be
9 allowed pursuant to Section 421 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
10 Statutes.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
