

1 B. As used in this section:

2 1. "First responder" shall mean a full-time, reserve, or
3 volunteer, state, county, or municipal peace officer, firefighter,
4 paramedic, emergency medical technician, rescue service personnel,
5 emergency manager, medical examiner or employee of a medical
6 examiner, or wrecker service provider;

7 2. "Investigating agency" shall mean the city, county, or state
8 agency responsible for investigating and reporting the collision to
9 the Department of Public Safety or the crime report to the Oklahoma
10 State Bureau of Investigation; and

11 3. "Scene support personnel" shall include, but not be limited
12 to, towing or remediation services, funeral homes, crime scene
13 cleaners, or city, county, and state road maintenance employees.

14 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
15 prevent the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation or the Oklahoma
16 Highway Patrol from transmitting information when a law enforcement
17 agency requests investigative assistance.

18 D. Within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this act,
19 any agency or entity employing first responders or scene support
20 personnel shall notify the employees of the provisions of this act.

21 E. Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall be
22 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed One
23 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail
24 not to exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
