9 An Act relating to firearms; amending 63 O.S. 2021,
10 Section 4210.3, which relates to the Oklahoma Boating
11 Safety Regulation Act; modifying scope of certain
12 unlawful act; removing mandatory minimum penalties;
13 deleting provision concerning the transport of
14 handguns by licensees; and providing an effective
15 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 4210.3, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 4210.3 It shall be unlawful to ~~transport a shotgun,~~
20 ~~rifle or pistol in or to discharge such weapons~~ a firearm from a
21 vessel, except for the purposes of self-defense, hunting animals or
22 fowl, and in compliance with existing state and federal laws.

23 Anyone violating the provisions of this section, upon conviction,
24 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of
not ~~less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)~~ and ~~not~~ more than One Hundred

1 Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not
2 ~~less than ten (10) days and not more than six (6)~~ three (3) months,
3 or by both such fine and imprisonment. ~~Any person in possession of~~
4 ~~a valid handgun license from this state or a reciprocal state~~
5 ~~authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not be deemed~~
6 ~~guilty of transporting a pistol in violation of this section when a~~
7 ~~handgun is carried concealed or unconcealed upon or about their~~
8 ~~person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-~~
9 ~~Defense Act.~~

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
