13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1192, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1192. Any person who shall inoculate himself <u>or herself</u>
16	or any other person or shall suffer himself or herself to be
17	inoculated with smallpox, syphilis or gonorrhea :
18	1. Smallpox;
19	2. Syphilis;
20	3. Gonorrhea;
21	4. Chlamydia;
22	5. Hepatitis B;
23	6. Genital herpes;
24	7. Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Infection; or

1	8. Trichomoniasis,
2	and shall spread or cause to be spread to any other persons with
3	intent to or recklessly be responsible for the spread of or
4	prevalence of such infectious disease, shall, upon conviction, be
5	deemed a felon, and, upon conviction thereof, guilty of a felony and
6	shall be punished punishable by imprisonment in the State
7	Penitentiary custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of
8	not more than five (5) years nor less than two (2) years.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
