22 A Joint Resolution relating to a Constitutional
23 Convention pursuant to Article V of the United States
24 Constitution; application; distribution.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
26 AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

27 Section 1. The Oklahoma Legislature of Oklahoma hereby makes an
28 application to Congress, as provided by Article V of the
29 Constitution of the United States of America, to call a convention
30 limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United
31 States of America to set a limit on the number of terms that a

1 person may be elected as a Member of the United States House of
2 Representatives and to set a limit on the number of terms that a
3 person may be elected as a Member of the United States Senate.

4 Section 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
5 transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary
6 of the Senate of the United States and to the Speaker, Clerk and
7 Judiciary Committee Chairman of the House of Representatives of the
8 Congress of the United States, and copies to the members of the said
9 Senate and House of Representatives from this State; also to
10 transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of each of the
11 legislative houses in the several States, requesting their
12 cooperation.

13 Section 3. This application shall be considered as covering the
14 same subject matter as the applications from other States to
15 Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the number of terms
16 that a person may be elected to the House of Representatives of the
17 Congress of the United States and the Senate of the United States;
18 and this application shall be aggregated with same for the purpose
19 of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require Congress
20 to call a limited convention on this subject, but shall not be
21 aggregated with any other applications on any other subject.

22 Section 4. This application constitutes a continuing
23 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the
24 United States of America until the legislatures of at least two-

1 thirds of the several states have made applications on the same
2 subject.
