9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1692.10 of Title 21, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The majority of the voters of a county, voting at an election to  
14 be held for such purpose, may approve reducing violations of  
15 Sections 1692.2, 1692.3, 1692.4, and 1692.5 of Title 21 of the  
16 Oklahoma Statutes to misdemeanor offenses. An election shall be  
17 called upon the filing of a petition with the county election board  
18 containing not less than five percent (5%) of the number of voters  
19 that voted in the most recent gubernatorial election in that county,  
20 or by a simple majority vote of the county commissioners in that  
21 county.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
