NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1096 of Title 64, unless there 13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 A. As used in this section, "unauthorized camp" means any tent, 15 shelter, or bedding constructed or arranged for the purpose of or in 16 such a way to permit overnight use on a property not designated as a 17 campsite. 18 B. Persons may not use state-owned lands for the purposes of 19 20 establishing an unauthorized camp. C. Any person who violates the provisions of this section 21 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a 22 fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment in the 23

county jail not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or by both such fine

1	and imprisonment. However, a person who commits a first violation
2	of this section shall be issued a warning, and a citation may not be
3	issued unless the person refuses any assistance offered to them by
4	the arresting officer. Such assistance may include, but is not
5	limited to, transportation to a shelter, food pantry, or other place
6	where resources are made available to assist the indigent and
7	homeless.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
