8	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department; amending 74 O.S. 2021,
9	Sections 2203, 2204, and 2206, which relate to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission; removing
10	function of Commission as an advisory body; providing provision for removal of Commission members;
11	transferring powers from the Executive Director to
12	the Commission; modifying powers and duties of Commission; authorizing Commission to appoint
13	Executive Director; allowing Commission to establish salary for the Executive Director; and providing an
14	effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2203, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 2203. A. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
20	Commission shall <del>be an advisory body to the Executive Director of</del>
21	the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department and shall consist of
22	eight (8) members who shall serve a term of six (6) years.
23	Effective January 14, 2019, all duties and powers of the Commission
24	shall be transferred to the Executive Director. Any provision in

- statute that provides to the Commission authority that is not

  advisory in nature shall be deemed to grant the duty or power to the

  Executive Director. No more than one Commission member shall be

  from any one county. The Lieutenant Governor shall serve as an ex

  officio voting member of the Commission.
  - B. One member shall be appointed from each congressional district, who shall be a resident and a qualified elector in the district from which appointed, and the remaining members shall be appointed from the state at large. If congressional districts are redrawn each member appointed shall complete the current term of office at which time a new appointment shall be made in compliance with the redrawn congressional district.
  - C. Commission members shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, and shall serve at the pleasure of the may be removed with cause by the Governor. Whenever a vacancy on the Commission occurs by death, resignation, or otherwise, the Governor shall fill the same by appointment, with the advice and consent of the Senate, and the appointee shall hold office during the unexpired term. Each member shall hold office until a successor has been appointed and qualified.
  - D. With the exception of the ex officio, no member of the Commission shall seek election to a federal, state, or county office while serving on the Commission.

- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2204, is

- 3 Section 2204. There are hereby granted to and imposed in the

- 5 commission or body which may hereafter succeed to the powers,

- 18 the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by law.
- 19 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2206, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 Section 2206. The chief executive officer of the Oklahoma
- 22 | Tourism and Recreation Department shall be the Executive Director,
- 23 who shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent
- 24 | of the Senate, Commission and who shall serve at the pleasure of the

1	Governor and may be removed or replaced without cause Commission.

3	training, experience, and ability to administer the functions of the
