Program to offer financial assistance by grant to private or public entities for the purpose of augmenting the aircraft engine testing capabilities of this state and developing aircraft engine testing infrastructure. Grant funding shall be administered based on merit and the potential for a specific project to enhance the aviation and earospace industry of this state. A grant under this program shall be a one-time award.

B. Public, private, and nonprofit entities within Oklahoma that
have sufficient financial and management capacity to complete the
requested project are eligible for funding under this program.
Applicants shall provide the following information:

Airline or industry support as evidenced by a letter or
 other communication directly from the entity stating its support for
 the project;

The ability to provide a minimum of forty percent (40%)
 matching funds for the project; and

A proposal summary that shall include any background
 information or history with aircraft engine testing and development,
 project description, timeline for completion of project, and
 estimated budget for the entire project.

C. A grant agreement shall be required between the awardee and the Commission to provide for conditions of disbursement of grant funds including obligation to repay funds if the terms of the

agreement are not met as well as providing ongoing quarterly reports
 detailing activity related to the project.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 503 of Title 3, unless there is 5 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 6 for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission to be designated the 7 "Oklahoma Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant Program 8 9 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received 10 by any public or private donations, contributions and gifts received 11 12 for the benefit of the fund, and any amounts appropriated by the Legislature. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are 13 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma 14 Aeronautics Commission for the purpose of funding grants as provided 15 in this act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants 16 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by 17 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 18 Services for approval and payment. 19

20 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma 21 Aircraft Engine Testing Development Grant Program Revolving Fund the 22 sum of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) or so much thereof as 23 may be necessary to carry out the purpose of the fund.

24 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
