15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 509.11, is

18	district, or employee organization shall deny by any means,
19	including a collective bargaining agreement, a statewide
20	professional educators' association equal access to employees of the
21	school district $_{ au}$ to the same extent that access is granted to other
22	educators' associations. For purposes of this section, access shall
23	include, but is not limited to:

1 1. Setting up informational tables at in-service or other 2 similar teacher meetings; 3 Speaking at in-service or other similar teacher meetings; 2. 4 Distributing information in school mail boxes or through the 3. 5 school e-mail system; 6 4. Utilizing school district meeting rooms during nonworking 7 hours: 8 5. Representing employees in employment matters, when requested 9 by the employee; 10 Posting information on school district bulletin boards; and 6. 11 7. Utilizing school district printing services. 12 Any association which utilizes school district facilities or Β. 13 services shall reimburse the district for any costs incurred by the 14 district. 15 C. A school district is prohibited from: 16 1. Requiring or coercing school district employees to meet, 17 communicate, listen to, or otherwise interact with an employee 18 organization or statewide professional educators' association; 19 2. Distributing communications or membership solicitations on 20 behalf of an employee organization or statewide professional 21 educators' association; and 22 3. Permitting an employee organization or statewide 23 professional educators' association access to or use of the school 24 district's meetings, events, facilities, communications systems, \_ \_

2	more favorable than extended to any other employee organization or
3	statewide professional educators' association seeking similar access

5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
