SENATE BILL 165

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public water supplies; prohibiting certain political subdivisions or public and private businesses from fluoridating a public water supply; directing the Department of Environmental Quality to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-6-311 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Every county, municipality, city, town, school, or political subdivision thereof, or public or private business operating in the state is hereby prohibited from introducing or depositing fluoride or any chemical containing fluoride into a public water supply. The Department of Environmental Quality shall promulgate rules to effectuate the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
