SENATE BILL 168

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission; prohibiting any provision from being enacted to prohibit or limit use of refrigerant designated as federally acceptable; requiring installation of certain equipment to maintain certain standards and conditions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.30 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No provision of a building code, any other law, regulation, or other requirement in Oklahoma may prohibit or otherwise limit the use of a refrigerant designated as acceptable for use pursuant to and in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 7671K; provided, any equipment containing such refrigerant is listed and installed in accordance with safety standards and use conditions imposed pursuant to such designation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
