6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the True Grit Trail; directing the
8 Department of Transportation to erect signage in
9 certain locations; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.431 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The Department of Transportation shall erect informational
16 highway signage designed or approved by the Oklahoma Tourism and
17 Recreation Department to direct visitors to sites of significant
18 interest along the True Grit Trail, including:

- 19 1. The City of Sallisaw;
20 2. The Town of Spiro;
21 3. The Town of Bokoshe;
22 4. The Town of McCurtain;
23 5. The Town of Kinta;
24 6. The Town of Quinton;

- 1 7. The City of Krebs;
- 2 8. The City of McAlester;
- 3 9. The City of Hartshorne;
- 4 10. The City of Wilburton;
- 5 11. Robbers Cave State Park;
- 6 12. The Town of Red Oak;
- 7 13. The Town of Bengal;
- 8 14. The Town of Talihina; and
- 9 15. The Talimena National Scenic Byway.

10 B. The Department of Transportation shall collaborate with the
11 Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to maintain online
12 resources for the True Grit Trail including but not limited to:

- 13 1. A map of the True Grit Trail;
- 14 2. Information about each of the sites of significant interest
15 identified in this section; and
- 16 3. Historical context regarding the True Grit Trail.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
