SENATE BILL 2035

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to vehicle license and registration; requiring license plates to be issued to motor vehicle and not the owner upon certain date; providing for transfer of plate between owners; authorizing Service Oklahoma to promulgate rules; repealing 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1112.2, as amended by Section 126, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 1112.2), which relates to transfer of license plates; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1112.2A of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Effective July 1, 2024, every motor vehicle license plate shall be issued to and remain with the motor vehicle it is initially registered to and shall be transferable between motor vehicle owners.

B. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules as may be required to implement the provisions of this section including, but not limited to, rules required for a system under which the license

3 SECTION 2. REPEALER 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1112.2, as
4 amended by Section 126, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp.
5 2023, Section 1112.2), is hereby repealed.

6 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

7 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
