7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to marijuana; allowing
9 municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties
10 to enter into certain agreements or memoranda of
11 understanding; designating reimbursement rate for
12 certain equipment usage; providing for codification;
13 and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426.2 of Title 63, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Municipalities, political subdivisions, and counties may enter
19 into agreements or memoranda of understanding with state agencies
20 which respond to search and seizure activities of marijuana to
21 compensate municipalities, political subdivisions, or counties for
22 the use of county or municipal equipment during search and seizure
23 events. Agreements or memoranda made pursuant to the provisions of
24 this section shall not be reimbursed at a higher rate than the
25 federal schedule rate for equipment usage.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
