State agencies, counties, cities, towns, 18 school districts, career technology districts, institutions of 19 higher education, public trusts, other entities or instrumentalities 20 of local government, and Internet service providers shall, at the 21 request of the Oklahoma Broadband Office, provide information to the 22 Office regarding any matters as specified in this act relevant to 23 the Office's duties.

4	the Office shall result in an Internet service provider or public
5	entity being ineligible to receive any grant or other assistance

7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
