5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to state employees; requiring certain
7 state agency develop certain system to provide
8 bonuses for certain state employees; requiring
9 Director to promulgate rules; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.18A of Title 74, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The Human Capital Management Division of the Office of
16 Management and Enterprise Services shall develop a system that
17 provides a differential bonus for state employees who have earned
18 degrees or certifications that were previously required for their
19 positions but are no longer considered mandatory for the position.

20 B. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
21 Services shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this
22 act.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
