SENATE BILL 685

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to art in public places; providing exemption from certain act; requiring signage be placed on certain projects; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9030.1a of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any project that is funded partially or fully by the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act. All projects related to the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding shall have signage that is displayed in a prominently visible location at the project site such as, but not limited to, a cornerstone. Such signage shall reference the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding and the year completed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
