14	2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 1-745.32), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 1-745.32. As used in this act:
17	1. <u>"Abortion" has the same meaning as provided by Section 1-730</u>
18	of this title;
19	2. "Fetal heartbeat" means cardiac activity or the steady and
20	repetitive rhythmic contraction of the fetal heart within the
21	gestational sac;
22	$\frac{2}{2}$ . "Gestational age" means the amount of time that has
23	elapsed from the first day of a woman's last menstrual period;

<sup>1</sup> 3. <u>4.</u> "Gestational sac" means the structure comprising the extraembryonic membranes that envelop the unborn child and that is typically visible by ultrasound after the fourth week of pregnancy;

4 4. 5. "Physician" means an individual licensed to practice
5 medicine in this state including a medical doctor and a doctor of
6 osteopathic medicine;

7 <u>5. 6.</u> "Pregnancy" means the human female reproductive condition 8 that:

9

a. begins with fertilization,

b. occurs when the woman is carrying the developing human
 offspring, and

12 c. is calculated from the first day of the woman's last 13 menstrual period;

<sup>14</sup> 6. <u>7.</u> "Standard medical practice" means the degree of skill, <sup>15</sup> care, and diligence that an obstetrician of ordinary judgment, <sup>16</sup> learning, and skill would employ in like circumstances;

<sup>17</sup> 7. 8. "Unborn child" means a human fetus or embryo in any stage <sup>18</sup> of gestation from fertilization until birth; and

<sup>19</sup> 8. <u>9.</u> "Woman" and "women" include any person whose biological <sup>20</sup> sex is female including any person with XX chromosomes and any <sup>21</sup> person with a uterus, regardless of any gender identity that the <sup>22</sup> person attempts to assert or claim.

2	2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 1-745.51), is amended to read as
3	follows:
4	Section 1-745.51. As used in this act:
5	1. "Abortion" means the act of using, prescribing,
6	administering, procuring, or selling of any instrument, medicine,
7	drug, or any other substance, device, or means with the purpose to
8	terminate the pregnancy of a woman, with knowledge that the
9	termination by any of those means will with reasonable likelihood
10	cause the death of an unborn child. It does not include the use,
11	prescription, administration, procuring, or selling of Plan B,
12	morning-after pills, or any other type of contraception or emergency
13	contraception. An act is not an abortion if the act is performed
14	with the purpose to:
15	a. save the life or preserve the health of the unborn
16	child,
17	b. remove a dead unborn child caused by spontaneous
18	abortion, or
19	c. remove an ectopic pregnancy
20	has the same meaning as provided by Section 1-730 of this title;
21	2. "Fertilization" means the fusion of a human spermatozoon
22	with a human ovum;
23	3. "Medical emergency" means a condition in which an abortion
