13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 41 O.S. 2021, Section 113, is

15	Section 113. A. A rental agreement may not provide that either		
16	party thereto:		
17	1. Agrees to waive or forego rights or remedies under the		
18	Oklahoma Residential Landlord and Tenant Act;		
19	2. Authorizes any person to confess judgment on a claim arising		
20	out of the rental agreement;		
21	3. Agrees to pay the other party's attorney's attorney fees;		
22	4. Agrees to the exculpation, limitation or indemnification of		
23	any liability arising under law for damages or injuries to persons		
24	or property caused by, or resulting from, the acts or omissions of		

1	either party, their agents, servants or employees in the operation
2	or maintenance of the dwelling unit or the premises of which it is a
3	part;

4 5. Agrees to the establishment of a lien except as allowed by
5 the Oklahoma Residential Landlord and Tenant Act in and to the
6 property of the other party; or

7 6. Agrees to waive or limit his or her right to summon a peace
8 officer or other emergency assistance in an emergency.

9 B. A provision prohibited by subsection A of this section and10 included in a rental agreement is unenforceable.

11 <u>C. All rental agreements shall have all applicable fees,</u>

12 including, but not limited to, rent payment late fees and

13 <u>application fees, listed clearly on the first page of the rental</u> 14 agreement.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
