6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to firearms; providing immunity for
8 law enforcement agencies that sell confiscated and
9 forfeited firearms at public auction; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 55 of Title 76, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 No law enforcement agency, including municipal police
16 departments and county sheriff departments, that lawfully
17 confiscates, forfeits, and subsequently sells to a person with a
18 valid federal firearms license, a firearm at public auction shall be
19 liable to any person or entity, or to the estate, successors, or
20 survivors of either, for any injury suffered, including wrongful
21 death and property damage, because of use of such firearm by
22 another.
