16	A. A person who disseminates or publishes a digitization	
17	depicting another person's name, image, or likeness without their	
18	written consent and with the intent to cause emotional, financial,	
19	or physical harm shall be guilty of a felony.	
20	B. Any digitization shall include a disclosure that the image	
21	is a digitization. Failure to disclose shall result in a	
22	misdemeanor.

- 1. The term "digitization" shall mean a still or video image that is altered to appear in a realistic manner utilizing an image or images of a person other than the person depicted or computergenerated images.
- 2. The term "disseminate" means to give, provide, lend, deliver, mail, send, forward, transfer, or transmit, electronically or otherwise, to another person.
 - 3. The term "publish" means:
 - a. to disseminate with the intent that such images be sold by another person, or
 - b. to post, present, display, exhibit, circulate, advertise, or allow access to, electronically or otherwise, so as to make an image or images available to the public.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
