AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; creating the Prohibition of Rank Choice Voting Act; prohibiting ranked-choice voting; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Prohibition of Rank Choice Voting Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-134 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A ranked-choice voting method that allows electors to rank candidates for an office in order of preference and has ballots cast be tabulated in multiple rounds following the elimination of a candidate until a single candidate attains a majority shall not be

1 used in determining the election or nomination of any candidate to
2 any local, state, or federal elective office in this state.

3 B. Any existing or future ordinance enacted or adopted by a
4 county, a municipality, or any other local governmental entity which
5 conflicts with this section is void.

6 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
