11 An Act relating to Tribal-State agreements; enacting
12 law to offer supplemental compact terms to affirm and
13 extend existing agreements pertaining to motor
14 vehicle registration and licensing; and providing for
15 severability.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1221.B of Title 74, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Legislature finds that:

21 1. Oklahoma has benefited from its implementation of the policy
22 set forth in Section 1221 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes
23 through, among other things, the formation and entry of
24

1 | intergovernmental agreements or compacts with Tribal nations on a
2 | variety of subjects;

3 | 2. As an exercise of executive authority consistent with this
4 | codified policy, the Oklahoma Governor formed and entered certain
5 | Tribal-State agreements relating to motor vehicle licensing and
6 | registration matters, which agreements have benefited all parties by
7 | reducing intergovernmental disputes and increasing revenues
8 | available for roads, bridges, schools, and other valuable community
9 | infrastructure.

10 | B. The State of Oklahoma now offers the following supplemental
11 | term to any Tribe that was, as of January 1, 2023, a party to a
12 | motor vehicle licensing or registration agreement previously
13 | executed by an Oklahoma Governor:

14 | AFFIRMATION AND EXTENSION OF

15 | MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING/REGISTRATION COMPACT

16 | Between the [NAME OF TRIBE]

17 | and the STATE OF OKLAHOMA

18 | The motor vehicle licensing or registration and license
19 | tag agreement formed and entered by the Oklahoma Governor and
20 | the [NAME OF TRIBE] is hereby affirmed as a compact between the
21 | STATE OF OKLAHOMA and [NAME OF TRIBE] and shall be in effect
22 | until December 31, 2024, and any action to unilaterally
23 | terminate or to issue written notice of the compact's
24 | nonrenewal prior to that date shall be null and void.

1 C. Tribal acceptance of this offer shall be indicated by letter
2 from the Tribal party's governing body or official reciting the
3 terms set forth above and delivered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
4 Such acceptance letter, including the terms set forth above and
5 delivered to the Oklahoma Tax Commission, shall then be filed with
6 the Oklahoma Secretary of State.

7 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act are severable and if any
8 part or provision shall be held void the decision of the court so
9 holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or
10 provisions of this act.
