18	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma			
19	Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill			
20	No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma			
21	Legislature, the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall,			
22	under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated			
23	to wildland fire response resources.			
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Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
Legislature, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars ($10,000.00) shall,
under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated
to advancing leadership in agricultural businesses.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
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Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Six Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$6,950,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to rural fire departments for replacement of equipment and gear burned during fires including truck chassis.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma

Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill

No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma

Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)

shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to rural fire coordinators to administer a wet hydrant program.

SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma

Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill

No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma

Legislature, the sum of Two Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,100,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be used for providing grants to incorporated municipalities affected by the extreme weather event that began February 7, 2021, and ended February 21, 2021, as provided for in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1091 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature.

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SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25). Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds

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from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been
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    approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
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
