17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
19 Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
20 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
21 year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of One Hundred Forty-five Million  
22 Dollars (\$145,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to  
23 provide site improvements and construction of needed facility  
24 upgrades at an industrial park in the state, in order to benefit the

1 state and its citizens by attracting large-scale economic activity  
2 and development that creates a substantial number of jobs in the  
3 state.
