15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.11.1.2 of Title 62, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
20	for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to be
21	designated the "Oklahoma Employment Security Commission Information
22	Technology Innovation Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a
23	continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall
24	consist of all monies appropriated to the revolving fund created

    herein. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
    appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of
 2
    Management and Enterprise Services for the purpose of augmenting the
 3
    information technology infrastructure of the Oklahoma Employment
 4

    Security Commission. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
    warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
 6
    prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
 7
    Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
