1 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 2 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Legislature (2023) COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE 3 FOR SENATE BILL NO. 33x By: Thompson (Roger) and Hall 4 of the Senate 5 and 6 Wallace and Martinez of the 7 House 8 9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE An Act relating to the Department of Human Services; 10 requiring that certain funds be utilized for certain purpose; requiring certain funding be used as 11 additional or supplemental funding; requiring certain funding be maintained at certain levels; requiring 12 certain joint approval prior to certain actions; requiring certain transfers to certain funds; 13 appropriating certain federal funds for certain program; authorizing early allocation of funds under 14 certain conditions; authorizing certain transfers; requiring the maintenance of certain records; 15 providing budgeting and expenditure limitations and procedures; providing for lapse of funds under 16 certain conditions; and requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures. 17 18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 19 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 20 Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st 21 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of 22 Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall be used for providing 23 Home and Community-Based Waiver services for persons with 24

1 developmental disabilities. These funds shall be used to provide 2 additional services and programs for persons with developmental disabilities in order to eliminate the Developmental Disabilities 3 Services Division Waitlist. Such funds shall be used to supplement 4 rather than replace existing resources and programs.

SECTION 2. From available funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the Department shall make permanent the supplemental daily reimbursement rate of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for childcare providers which was in effect in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department shall maintain the funding levels for senior nutrition programs from the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. The Oklahoma Legislature requires joint approval from the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives before any senior nutrition sites may be closed due to declining attendance or increased operational costs during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Human Services shall transfer Five Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,600,000.00) to the credit of the Child Abuse

10A of the Oklahoma Statutes, which shall be distributed according

to Section 1-9-104 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

- SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services all federal monies received by the state during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Fund Block Grant to meet the provisions of federal law relating to such grants.
- request through the Director of the Office of Management and
 Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax

 Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.
 - SECTION 7. A. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall transfer monies appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services' disbursing funds in the amounts and ratios requested by the agency except that the cumulative amount transferred shall not exceed the cumulative amount of equal monthly allotments of the appropriations from the General Revenue Fund.
- B. Monies appropriated or collected for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, may be transferred to these disbursing funds for the

fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to satisfy encumbrances and obligations of the fiscal year, provided that monies equal in amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to the disbursing funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, to satisfy encumbrances and obligations of the fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in writing to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

C. The Department of Human Services shall maintain records of such inter-year transfers.

SECTION 8. The Director of Human Services may request the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer monies between the Department of Human Services Support Service Providers Grant Program Fund and the Human Services Disbursing Fund or the Human Services Medical and Assistance Fund, as needed for the expenditure of funds.

SECTION 9. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25). Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then

current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
