10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; making an appropriation;
11	identifying source; establishing amount; providing purpose; requiring and limiting the utilization of
12	funds; creating certain special account; limiting duration of account; requiring certain
13	determinations; providing and limiting the nature of the account and the funds within the account;
14	authorizing agency to submit request for certain deposits or transfers; requiring certain compliance
15	and verifications; authorizing certain memorandums of understanding; limiting scope; prohibiting certain
16 17	memoranda terms; authorizing and limiting the promulgation of rules and utilization of procedures; authorizing and limiting the retention of monies for
18	administration costs; requiring certain reports and submissions to certain entities; requiring appearance
19	before certain joint committee; limiting duration of certain requirements; providing determination
20	process; establishing requirements; and declaring an emergency.
21	
22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
23	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
24	Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise

1 appropriated from the Statewide Recovery Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 2 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Five Million Dollars 3 (\$5,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement 4 5 teacher acceleration programs which target high need teaching resources to address educational disparities that were exacerbated 6 by the pandemic. Such funds shall be utilized in a manner 7 consistent with the recommendations adopted by the Joint Committee 8 9 on Pandemic Relief Funding on May 19, 2023.

10 SECTION 2. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a Statewide Recovery Special Account for the Oklahoma State Regents 11 for Higher Education for the appropriated monies as provided for in 12 13 Section 1 of this act. The duration of such account shall continue for the period of time that monies related to the American Rescue 14 Plan Act of 2021 are being budgeted, expended, or managed in the 15 state. The ending of such period shall be determined by the State 16 Treasurer, and shall result in the closing of such account as a 17 matter of law. Such account shall be a continuing account as 18 otherwise provided in this section, not subject to fiscal year 19 limitations, and shall exclusively consist of monies related to the 20 relevant appropriation made in this act and as otherwise directed by 21 law. All monies deposited to the credit of such account are hereby 22 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma State 23 Regents for Higher Education in accordance with the provisions of 24

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this act. Expenditures from such account shall be made upon
 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

5 Β. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are authorized to request in writing that the monies appropriated by the 6 provisions of this act be deposited or transferred to the account 7 created pursuant to subsection A of this section. No later than 8 9 seven (7) calendar days from the date of such request, the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall comply 10 with such request and verify to the requesting agency that such 11 deposit or transfer has been completed. 12

SECTION 3. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education may 13 enter into memorandums of understanding with other agencies of the 14 State of Oklahoma for the auditing, documentation, evaluation, 15 implementation, oversight, reporting, and management of funds and 16 associated efforts related to the appropriation made in this act; 17 provided, no such memorandum of understanding shall require or 18 include, as an option or condition, the direct or practical transfer 19 or relinquishment of control by the agency appropriated such funds 20 to budget, expend, allocate, and request the distribution of the 21 funds appropriated by this act. 22

23 SECTION 4. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education may 24 promulgate rules, utilize existing rules, establish procedures, and

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1 utilize existing procedures to implement the provisions of this act,
2 provided such rules and procedures do not conflict with or impede
3 the provisions of this act.

SECTION 5. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education
shall retain no more than two percent (2%) of the funds appropriated
by this act to reimburse:

7 1. Costs incurred by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher8 Education; or

9 2. Costs incurred on the agency's behalf,
10 associated with the administration of the appropriated funds and
11 programming required by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
12 Education under the provisions of this act; provided, no funds shall
13 be retained that would be disallowable under the provisions of the
14 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

15 SECTION 6. A. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education 16 shall:

Submit to the chairs of the Joint Committee on Pandemic
 Relief Funding, or any successor of the Oklahoma State Senate or
 Oklahoma House of Representatives legislative committee or joint
 committee, as designated by the President Pro Tempore of the
 Oklahoma State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
 Representatives:

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- a. a written or electronic quarterly report detailing the
 budgeting, expenditure, and management of all monies
 appropriated in this act, and
- b. a copy of all memorandums of understanding and
 contracts with third parties entered into by the
 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to
 facilitate, assist, or administer powers and duties
 provided to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
 Education under the provisions of this act; and

At the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding's request,
 appear before the Joint Committee no later than six (6) months after
 the effective date of this act, and as otherwise requested by the
 Joint Committee to provide a status update regarding the
 implementation of the provisions of this act.

The provisions of subsection A of this section shall remain 15 Β. applicable for the period of time that monies appropriated under 16 17 this act are being budgeted, expended, or managed in the state. The ending of such period shall be determined by the State Treasurer, 18 and shall be reported to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the 19 Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of 20 Representatives. 21

SECTION 7. For all projects funded in this measure, if a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization may help implement the project, the

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1 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall require the 2 nonprofit show that it:

1. Provides direct services to residents of Oklahoma; 3 2. Is in good standing with the Office of the Secretary of 4 5 State; 6 3. Is in compliance with the applicable federal and Oklahoma tax laws for years 2019, 2020, and 2021; and 7 4. Continues to provide its good standing with the Office of 8 9 the Secretary of State and is in compliance with applicable federal and Oklahoma tax laws for all years the nonprofit is helping 10 implement the program. 11 SECTION 8.
