**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1006x appropriates the following amounts to the Department of Agriculture for the following purposes:

- \$2 million for wildland fire response resources;
- \$10,000 for advancing leadership in agricultural business;
- \$6.95 million to rural fire departments for replacing equipment and gear burned during fires including truck chassis;
- \$100,000 for rural fire coordinators to administer a wet hydrant program;
- \$2.1 million for providing grants to incorporated municipalities affected by the winter storm that took place February 2, 2021 through February 21, 2021;

The measure details how the funds must be encumbered.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB1006X appropriates the following amounts to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry:

- \$2,000,000 for wildland fire response resources
- \$10,000 for advancing leadership in agricultural businesses
- \$6,950,000 to rural fire departments for replacement of equipment and gear
- \$100,000 to rural fire coordinators to administer a wet hydrant program
- \$2,100,000 for providing grants to incorporated municipalities affected by the extreme weather event that occurred from Feb. 7, 2021 to Feb. 21, 2021
