**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 1013 deletes sexual orientation and gender identity from the list of factors by which visitation will not be restricted.

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HB 1013, as amended, establishes the Lori Brand Patient Bill of Rights Act of 2023 which outlines 30 rights afforded to patients receiving treatment in the state. The measure also includes 8 rights afforded to minors that are receiving treatment in the state, and places 11 responsibilities on patients and legal guardians of minor patients. Among which are to:

- To provide accurate and complete information concerning the patient's present complaints, past illnesses, hospitalizations, medications, and other matters relating to his or her health.
- To report perceived risks in the patient's care and unexpected changes in his or her condition to the responsible health care provider.
- To ask questions when the patient does not understand what he or she has been told about the patient's care or what he or she is expected to do.
