HB1033 raises the cap any person, attorney, or licensed child-placing agency which wants to pay living and transportation expenses on behalf of a birth mother can spend without first obtaining court approval to \$3,500.00 plus deposits for housing and utilities for such costs and expenses. The cap originally was \$1,000.00.
