**Research Analysis**

HB 1041, as introduced, creates an alternative diploma, with alternative requirements, for severely disabled students who participate in the Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program. The measure clarifies that students participating in the alternative assessment program will not be precluded from attempting to meet the requirements of a standard diploma.
