Research Analysis

HB1043, as introduced, requires that a DHS licensed child care provider receive reimbursement at the beginning of each week in which half is based on enrollment and half is based on actual daily attendance. The rate will be determined by the tier level of the facility and the age of each child on subsidy program contract. The Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card will only be swiped on days attended. If a child misses 10 consecutive days, the child may lose approval for the child care subsidy program and may need to reapply. DHS must conduct an annual market rate survey to ensure compliance with the federally required payment rate.
