Research Analysis

The proposed subcommittee substitute for HB 1043 provides that a child care facility licensed by the Department of Human Services (DHS) with a current child care provider will receive reimbursement at the beginning of each week, 50% of which will be based on enrollment and 50% of which will be based on actual daily attendance. The reimbursement rate will be determined by the facility's tier level and the age of each child on the subsidy contract minus the family copayment. The child Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) care will only be swiped in on days in attendance and will not be required to be swiped out. The child may lose approval for the child care subsidy program and may be required to reapply in the event that they miss 10 consecutive days of attendance without prior approval. Last, DHS will conduct an annual market rate survey to ensure compliance with the seventy-fifth-percentile payment rate required by the federal Child Care and Development Block Grant.
