**Research Analysis**

HB 1077 directs the Department of Public Safety to develop and implement a statewide Kasey Alert system to be activated on behalf of a critically missing adult. A critically missing adult is a person between the ages of 18 and 59 whose whereabouts are unknown and who is believed to have been abducted or taken against his or her will.
