Research Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute for HB1254 prohibits consumer reporting agencies from sharing a credit report with a third-party unless the third-party has a pre-existing relationship with the consumer who requested the credit report or the consumer consents to sharing the report.

Violators will be subject to a \$10,000 civil penalty payable to the person that is adversely affected by the action. Joint applicants for credit that are adversely affected will be entitled to \$10,000 each. The Attorney General is responsible for enforcing this act.
