Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1320, prohibits the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from authorizing payments through the state Medicaid program to an out-of-state medical provider unless that state also allows their residents to contract with providers under their state Medicaid program in Oklahoma.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1320 in its current form requires the state Medicaid program to require reciprocity from other states reimbursing Oklahoma providers under their Medicaid program before Oklahoma reimburses out-of-state providers under Oklahoma's Medicaid plan. Such reciprocity would result in the reimbursement of Oklahoma providers through the Medicaid programs of reciprocal states; yielding improved reimbursements for in-state providers at no additional cost to Oklahoma. The measure is not anticipated to have a material impact on the state budget or appropriations.
