Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 1350 requires the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to make applications for temporary medical marijuana licenses available on its website in an easy-to-find location.

Temporary licenses will be for:

- Medical marijuana commercial growers
- Medical marijuana processors
- Medical marijuana dispensaries
- Medical marijuana transporters
- Medical marijuana businesses

The application fee for licenses will be a nonrefundable fee of \$1,000. Licenses will be valid for only 180 days from the effective date, and may be extended by OMMA for additional 90 day periods not to exceed 18 months for a nonrefundable fee of \$1,000 per extension.

The measure expands the definition of "financial interest", outlines the documents necessary to apply for a temporary license, and establishes the guidelines warranting an extension. The measure also allows for the temporary licensing fee to be subtracted from the initial fee for an annual license.

The measure removes firefighters from the list of safety-sensitive jobs. Thus allowing them to consume medical marijuana on the job without repercussions.

The CS to HB 1350 allow a temporary the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to issue temporary licenses for a non-refundable fee of \$1,000 and will be valid for 180 days and be amendable up to 90 days not to exceed 18 months.
