Research Analysis

The first amendment to HB 1372 clarifies that a candidate that receives more than 50% of the vote during a primary election will be elected to office and will be seated at the first meeting following the April election date and certification.

HB1372 specifies that in a case where there are more than two school board candidates, if an individual receives 50% or more of the vote in the primary then they will be elected to the office and will be seated at the first meeting following the April election date. The measure clarifies that the board of education will select a President and Vice President from the school board after the April election and certification.
